

[Municipality Name] Municipal Bylaw: Prohibition of Sale and Trade of Designated Invasive Plants

Preamble

WHEREAS, invasive plants pose a significant threat to the local ecosystem, disrupting native flora and fauna, and causing ecological imbalances;

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of this municipality to protect and preserve the local environment and biodiversity for the benefit of present and future generations;

WHEREAS, a list of designated invasive plants has been established to aid in the effective implementation of measures to prevent their sale and trade;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted by the [Municipality Name] Council as follows:

Section 1: Title and Purpose
